Flee, Follow, and Fight

(1 Timothy 6:11-12)

"Flee"

- Paul informed that there are some things that one must flee. (1 Timothy 6:11)
- To "flee" denotes: "to run away from a place or a situation of danger."
- The Bible is full of admonitions to flee.
 - We must flee sexual immorality. (1 Corinthians 6:18)
 - We must flee temptation. (1 Corinthians 10:13)
 - We must flee idolatry. (1 Corinthians 10:14)
 - We must flee error and greed. (1 Timothy 6:3-11)
- It's not enough to just "walk away" slowly, but rather we must "run away" if we are going to defeat these things. (James 4:7)

"Follow"

- Paul also informed that there are some things that must be followed. (1 Timothy 6:11)
- To "follow" denotes the need to "pursue or to go after something."
- Paul clearly lays out some things that Christians are to follow. (1 Timothy 6:11)
 - Pursue righteousness. (Proverbs 15:9; Matthew 5:6)
 - Pursue godliness. (1 Timothy 4:7-8, 6:6)
 - Pursue faith. (Hebrews 11:6; 1 John 5:4)
 - Pursue love. (1 Corinthians 14:1; Romans 13:8-10)
 - Pursue patience. (Mark 13:13; James 1:12)
 - Pursue gentleness. (Galatians 6:1; Ephesians 4:1-2)
- Following the will of the Lord, has it's reward. (John 12:26)

"Fight"

- Paul also spoke of the need to fight the good fight of faith. (1 Timothy 6:12)
- We need to understand what kind of fight we are engaged in, and we must be properly prepared for battle. (2 Corinthians 10:3-6; Ephesians 6:10-18)
- As Christians we must wage the good warfare, and fight the good fight. (1 Timothy 1:18-19)
- Endure hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ, and fight the good fight. (2 Timothy 2:3-4, 4:7)

What Must I Do To Be Saved?

- Hear the word of God. (Romans 10:17)
- Believe in Jesus Christ. (John 8:24)
- Repent of your sins. (Acts 17:30)
- Confess Jesus Christ. (Matthew 10:32)
- Be baptized for the remission of sins. (Acts 2:38)
- Remain faithful unto death. (Revelation 2:10)
