Gender Roles In The Home and Church

Gender Roles In The Home

- God's design of male and female shows that He did not, and that He does not, intend for one gender (i.e. a male or a female) to assume both roles. (Genesis 1:27)
- Man is to be the leader of the home, and the women are to be submissive to the authority of their husband. (Genesis 3:16; Ephesians 5:22-24)
- Women are to manage (i.e. guide the affairs or to do what is proper for the good of) the home and family. (1 Timothy 5:14; Titus 2:5)

Gender Roles In The Home

- Man is to be the provider of both the spiritual and the physical provisions of the home. (Genesis 18:19; Joshua 24:15; Ephesians 6:4; 1 Timothy 5:8)
- Men and Women are to respect one another's respective role that God has placed for them in the home. (Ephesians 5:33; 1 Peter 3:7)

Gender Roles In The Church

- God's plan is for women to be in subjection to men in the church, and for women to assert no authority over a man. (1 Timothy 2:11-12)
- God's plan is for men to serve as elders, deacons, and evangelist in the church, and not for women to serve as such. (1 Timothy 3:1-13; 2 Timothy 4:5)

Gender Roles In The Church

- Although God has limited a woman's role in the church, a woman can still be an asset to the work of the church by teaching and by admonishing other women and children by the word of God, and by setting a godly example for others to see and follow. (Titus 2:3-5; 1 Peter 3:1)
- Once more, God has spoken in regard to the role of men and women in the church, and we must not go beyond what He has authorized in regard to the role of men and women in the church. (1 Timothy 2:12; 2 John 9)

What Must I Do To Be Saved?

- Hear the word of God. (Romans 10:17)
- Believe in Jesus Christ. (Acts 8:37)
- Repent of your sins. (Acts 17:30)
- Confess Jesus Christ. (Romans 10:9-10)
- Be baptized for the remission of sins. (Acts 2:38)
- Remain faithful unto death. (Revelation 2:10)
