# God Is The Creator of All

- The word “creator” is defined as “one that brings something into existence.”
- God made the world and everything in it. (Acts 17:24)
- God gives to all life, breath, and all things. (Acts 17:25)
- We (i.e. mankind) are the offspring of God. (Acts 17:29)
- Since God is our Almighty Creator, we should seek Him, and worship Him. (Acts 17:22-29)

# God Is The Sustainer of All

- The word “sustainer” is defined as “one who upholds or maintains something.”
- Keep in mind, as Paul informed, God needs nothing, but we need Him. (Acts 17:25)
- Keep in mind, for in Him (i.e. God) we live, move and have our being. (Acts 17:28)
- To be simply put, without God, we would not and could not exist! (Acts 17:26-28)

# God Is The Judge of All

- **God has appointed a day in which He will judge the world. (Acts 17:30-31)**
- **God (i.e. the Father) will judge the world in righteousness by His Son, Jesus Christ. (Acts 17:31; Romans 2:16)**
- **Keep in mind, judgment will be according to the word of the Lord. (John 12:48)**
- **Never forget, we shall all someday stand before the judgment of Christ. (Romans 14:10-12; 2 Corinthians 5:10)**

# What Must I Do To Be Saved?

- **Hear the word of God. (Romans 10:17)**
- **Believe in Jesus Christ. (John 8:24)**
- **Repent of your sins. (Acts 17:30)**
- **Confess Jesus Christ. (Matthew 10:32)**
- **Be baptized for the remission of your sins. (Acts 2:38)**
- **Remain faithful unto death. (Revelation 2:10)**
