- The church of the Thessalonians was an exemplary church in that they received the word of God in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Spirit, and they became examples to believers. (1 Thessalonians 1:6-7)

- The church of the Thessalonians was an exemplary church in that from them the word of the Lord was sounded forth, and their faith toward God had gone out. (1 Thessalonians 1:8)
- The church of the Thessalonians was an exemplary church in that they were truly converted to the living and true God. (1 Thessalonians 1:9)
- The church of the Thessalonians was an exemplary church in that they expected, and waited for the return of Jesus Christ who delivers us from the wrath to come. (1 Thessalonians 1:10)
