I. Spiritual Food Is Essential For Growth

- If we are going to grow spiritually, we must not live by bread alone. (Matthew 4:4)
- If we are going to grow spiritually, we must desire the pure milk of the word, so that we can grow thereby. (1 Peter 2:2)
- If we are going to grow spiritually, it is essential for us to feed upon spiritual food, lest we become spiritually malnourished. (Hebrews 5:12-14)

II. Regular Spiritual Exercise Is Essential For Growth

- If we are going to grow spiritually, we need to exercise ourselves toward godliness. (1 Timothy 4:7)
- Searching the Scriptures daily is a form of spiritual exercise. (Acts 17:11)
- If we are going to grow spiritually, we must study the Scriptures. (2 Timothy 2:15)
- Let's all engage in regular spiritual exercise by meditating day and night upon God's word, and let's grow spiritually. (Psalm 1:1-3)

III. A Good Environment Is Essential For Growth

- If we are going to grow spiritually, we must avoid evil company which corrupts good habits or good morals. (1 Corinthians 15:33)
- If we are going to mature and grow spiritually, we must avoid the path of the wicked. (Proverbs 4:14-15)
- If we are going to grow spiritually, we must choose our friends wisely. (Proverbs 12:26)
- Seek to grow spiritually, remembering, he who walks with wise men will be wise. (Proverbs 13:20)

IV. The Right Temperature Is Essential For Growth

- If we are going to grow spiritually, we must have a zeal that is on fire for the Lord. (Romans 12:11)
- Know that being lukewarm makes the Lord sick. So, seek to have the right temperature, and be one who is zealous for the Lord. (Revelation 3:14-16)

V. Frequent Spiritual Self-Examinations Are Essential For Spiritual Growth

- The inspired apostle Paul understood that spiritual self-examinations are essential for one's spiritual growth. (2 Corinthians 13:5)
- If we are going to grow spiritually, we must often consider and examine our ways. (Haggai 1:5)
- Let's all engage in spiritual self-examinations, let's think about our ways, and let's not delay to make needed changes. (Psalm 119:59-60)

- Hear the word of God. (Romans 10:17)
- Believe in Jesus Christ. (John 8:24)
- Repent of your sins. (Luke 13:3, 5)
- Confess Jesus Christ. (Romans 10:9-10)
