# **It Is Well With My Soul**

- As a faithful child of God it should be well with our soul whether temporal circumstances are good (i.e. peace like a river) or bad (i.e. sorrows like sea billows), and we should always have trust and find peace in the Lord no matter what the circumstance may be. (John 14:27; Philippians 4:11-13; Hebrews 13:5-6)**
- When the trials of this life come upon us it is going to be helpful for us to think about what Christ has done for us so that we do not become weary and discouraged in our souls, but rather confidently say “It is well with my soul.” (Hebrews 12:1-3)**

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- It should be well with our soul when we consider the implications of what Christ did for us when He died upon the cross, and by appreciating what He has done for us is cause for praise and joy which will allow for us to confidently say “It is well with my soul.”  
(Isaiah 53:3-12; Galatians 2:20; Philippians 4:4; 1 Peter 2:21-24)**
- The peace and contentment present in the heart of the faithful Christian is anchored by the hope of something that will be fully realized on the Day of Judgment, allowing us to confidently say “It is well with my soul.” (2 Timothy 4:6-8; Hebrews 6:17-19; 1 Peter 1:3-9)**
