Religious Practices That Are Not According To Christ...

- Permitting women to be elders, deacons, and preachers is a practice that is not according to Christ. (1 Timothy 2:12; 1 Timothy 3:1-2, 11-12)
- Using mechanical instruments in worship to God today is a practice that is not according to Christ. (Ephesians 5:19; Colossians 3:16)
- The sending of funds from the church treasury to fund man-made organizations is a practice that is not according to Christ. (Acts 11:29; Romans 12:13, 15:26; Philippians 4:15-16)

Religious Practices That Are Not According To Christ...

- The practice of building and funding a fellowship hall, a gymnasium, or a play ground for the recreation of the church is a practice not according to Christ. (Romans 1:16, 14:17; 1 Corinthians 11:17-22)
- The practice of having a church provide a day care center or a preschool is a practice that is not according to Christ. (1 Timothy 3:15)
- The practice of having a church organize a bake sale or car wash to fund the work of the church is not according to Christ. (1 Corinthians 16:1-2)
- The practice of observing the Lord's Supper monthly, quarterly, or annually is a practice not according to Christ. (1 Corinthians 11:23-26; Acts 20:7)
