All Have Sinned and Are In Need of A Savior

- All have sinned. (Romans 3:23)

- Jesus gave us a perfect example to follow on how to resist temptation. (Matthew 4:1-11)
- Jesus gave a perfect example to follow in how to be obedient. (John 6:38; Philippians 2:8)
- Let's all strive to be one who follows the example of Jesus. (1 Peter 2:21-24; 1 John 2:6)

All Need Jesus To Have True Peace of Mind

- Jesus Christ provides a true peace to those who will follow Him. (John 14:27)
- True peace is only found in Jesus Christ. (John 16:33)
- Paul said, “the peace of God which surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:7)
