## Why We Do Not Use Mechanical Instruments In Worship

- We do not use mechanical instruments in worship today because we do not live under the law of Moses today. For we live under the law of Christ today. (2 Chr. 29:25; Ps. 150; Gal. 6:2; Heb. 7:12, 22, 8:7)
- We do not use mechanical instruments in worship because this is a practice that can not be done by the authority of Christ. (Mt. 28:18; Col. 3:16-17)
- We do not use mechanical instruments in worship because there are only two sources of religious practice, from heaven or from men, and if it's a practice from men it is to have no part in our worship. (Mt. 21:23-27; Mk. 7:7-9; Col. 2:8)

## Why We Do Not Use Mechanical Instruments In Worship

- We do not use mechanical instruments in worship because this practice transgresses the doctrine of Christ, which leaves one without God. (2 Jn. 9)
- We do not use mechanical instruments in worship because this practice was not practiced or taught by Jesus Christ, His apostles, or by the early New Testament Christians. (Mt. 26:30; Mk. 14:26; Ac. 16:25; Rom. 15:9; 1 Cor. 14:15; Eph. 5:19; Col. 3:16; Heb. 2:12, 13:15; Jas. 5:13)

## Why We Do Not Use Mechanical Instruments In Worship

- We do not use mechanical instruments in worship because one can not worship God in spirit and in truth with it. (Jn. 4:24)
- We do not use mechanical instruments in worship today because to do so is to practice lawlessness, and to practice anything without the authority of Christ will cause Him to someday declare "I never knew you, depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness." (Mt. 7:21-23; Lk. 6:46; Jn. 12:48, 14:15, 14:21; Heb. 5:9)

- Repent of your sins. (Acts 17:30)
- Confess Jesus Christ. (Romans 10:9-10)
