Behave Like A Christian (Romans 12)

- Christians are to be totally committed and devoted to the service of God. (v. 1)**
- Christians must not be conformed to (i.e. be like) this world. (v. 2)**
- Christians must not think too highly of self. (v. 3)**
- Christians need to realize the need to do their part as a member of the body of Christ. (vv. 4-8)**
- Christians are to love without hypocrisy. (v. 9)**

Behave Like A Christian

(Romans 12)

- Christians are to abhor evil. (v. 9)**
- Christians are to cling to what is good. (v. 9)**
- Christians are to be kind, loving, and respectful to one another. (v. 10)**
- Christians are to always be zealous in serving the Lord. (v. 11)**
- Christians are to rejoice in hope. (v. 12)**
- Christians are to be patient in tribulation. (v. 12)**
- Christians are to continue steadfastly in prayer. (v. 12)**

Behave Like A Christian

(Romans 12)

- Christians are to distribute to the needs of the saints. (v. 13)**
- Christians are to be given to hospitality. (v. 13)**
- Christians are to show kindness, even to those who persecute them. (v. 14)**
- Christians are to be compassionate. (v. 15)**
- Christians are to be unified. (v. 16)**
- Christians are not to set their mind on high things, but are to associate with the humble. (v. 16)**

Behave Like A Christian

(Romans 12)

- Christians must not be one who is wise in their own opinion. (v.16)**
- Christians are to repay no one evil for evil. (v. 17)**
- Christians are to have regard for good things in the sight of all men. (v. 17)**
- Christians are to endeavor to live peaceably with all men. (v. 18)**
- Christians are not to avenge self. (vv. 19-20)**
- Christians are not to be overcome by evil, but are to overcome evil with good. (v. 21)**

What Must I Do To Be Saved?

- **Hear the word of God. (Romans 10:17)**
- **Believe in Jesus Christ. (John 8:24)**
- **Repent of your sins. (Luke 13:3, 5)**
- **Confess Jesus Christ. (Romans 10:9-10)**
- **Be baptized into Christ for the remission of your sins. (Acts 2:38; Galatians 3:27-29)**
- **Remain faithful unto death. (Revelation 2:10)**
