



Scenes From The Cross of Christ

The Scene Underneath The Cross

- Here we find Jesus being led away on His way to be crucified. (John 19:16-17)
- Jesus would have had lingering pain from the beatings and scourging which was inflicted upon Him. (Matthew 26:67, 27:27-31)
- Jesus became weakened (i.e. burdened) under the weight of it. (Luke 23:26)

The Scene Upon The Cross

- **Here we find Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God. (Luke 22:70; Matthew 27:41-43, 54)**
- **While hanging upon the cross the garments of Jesus was divided. (Matthew 27:35)**
- **Here we find a very compassionate and a forgiving Jesus. (Luke 23:34)**
- **Here, Jesus Christ hung suspended for 6hrs before dying. (Mark 15:25, 34-37)**

The Scene Above The Cross

- Here we have an inscription of the accusation of Jesus. (Mark 15:26)
- The inscription was written by Pilate. (John 19:19)
- The inscription was written in three different languages. (Luke 23:38; John 19:20)
- Also, above the cross was the scene of three hours of darkness. (Mark 15:33)

The Scene Below The Cross

- **Here, below the cross of Christ we have a picture of heartless cruelty. (Mark 15:29-30; Luke 23:35-37)**
- **Here the chief priest and scribes mocked Jesus Christ. (Mark 15:31-32)**
- **Here the Roman soldiers were found casting lots for the clothing of Jesus. (John 19:23-24)**

The Scene By The Cross

- Here we have two criminals, a criminal on the right, and another on the left. (Luke 23:33, 39-43)
- Here we find Mary, the mother of Jesus, along with other family and friends. (John 19:25)
- We also find by the cross of Christ the disciple whom Jesus loved. (John 19:26-27)
- Here we find a centurion and those with him who were guarding Jesus who witnessed the things that had happened after Jesus died, and they feared greatly, saying, truly this was the Son of God. (Matthew 27:50-54)

- **Believe in Jesus Christ. (John 8:24)**
- **Repent of your sins. (Acts 17:30)**
- **Confess Jesus Christ before men. (Matthew 10:32)**
